The pay and the date of increment would be fixed in accordance with clarification No. 2 contained in Deptt. of Expenditure O.M. No. 1/1/2202-IC dated 13.09.2008,No. 35034/3/2008-Estt. (D) dated 16.11.2009 and No. 11 of O.M. No. 35034/3/2008-Estt. (D) dated 09.09.2010.
