Subject:--Leasing of Defence land to Indian Oil Corporation for retail
outlets/Service Stations.

Sir,

I am directed to invite a reference to the Ministry's Letter No.10/52/
L/L&C/64/3200/D(Lands) dated 12th April, 1972 as amended vide this Ministry's
Corrigendum No.18/152/L/L&C/64/10032/D(Lands) dated 15th October, 1972 on the
subject mentioned above. It has been decided that the letter dated 12.4.72 may
be further amended as follows:-

- (1) In clause (1) of para 1, the words " Ex-officers" may be deleted.
- (2) The following may be added as sub clauses below clause(2) of para
1:- " Ex-servicemen whose total monthly income from all sources is
more than Rs.200/-PM will not be eligible".

contd.....

"Ex-servicemen who have already taken Defence lands on lease for agricultural or other purpose will not be eligible.

- (3) In place of the existing para 2, the following may be substituted:-
"The dealership cannot be transferred without the prior permission of the Government. While agreeing to transfer Government may enhance the rent and premium. Government may refuse permission to transfer if the lessee fails to agree to pay the enhanced rent and premium."
- (4) In place of para 3, the following may be substituted:- "These orders will remain in force for the period upto 12th April, 1974."
